Last Day for Refunds

First Summer Session (Term 202040): Last Day for Refunds- May 22 Eleven-Week Summer Session (Term 202050): Last Day for Refunds- June 15 Second Summer Session (Term 202060): Last Day for Refunds- July 1

REFUND POLICY: It is to the financial advantage of all students withdrawing, or dropping, classes to do so as early in the semester as possible. Refunds for **tuition and required fees*** will be made as follows for students who withdraw or drop to a lower amount of credit hours:
