## **Finance Security – Reminder and Changes**

Initial access to Finance data in Banner, ecuBIC or ODS should be submitted through the Banner Security Request application in PiratePort. Add a comment for ecuBIC or ODS access.

Semi-annual Banner Finance security reviews were converted to the ITCS Banner Security Review process in response to the new <u>User Access Control Standard</u> implemented in February 2022. Supervisors are now required to approve their direct reports' security on a semi-annual basis which will include both the security class and organization access information.
