- 1.) Students and authorized users can pay tuition and fees on-line through ECU's eBill system with the following payment methods.
-Visa, MasterCard, American Express or Discover affiliated credit cards with a 2.85% convenience fee.
-E-Check with no fee.
- 2.) Students can access ECU's eBill system through Pirate Port
-Students will need their Pirate ID and Passphrase to enter Pirate Port.

Important Dates

April 7, 2021	All Summer 2021 billing statements are due. All outstanding balances on a student's billing statement must be paid in full. All schedules will be cancelled for non-payment after 5:00 pm.
April 7, 2021	For the Summer 2021 term, the University will assess a \$25.00 processing fee beginning on April 7, 2021 for all accounts not paid in full, secured by a tuition payment plan or pending financial aid by 5:00 pm. Additionally, any student incurring tuition and fee charges for the first time after April 8, 2021 will be assessed a \$25.00 processing fee.
April 26, 2021	First day of class.
May 5, 2021	All schedules will be cancelled for non-payment after 5:00 pm.
May 6, 2021	Starting May 6, 2021, a schedule can only be reinstated when proof of attendance from instructors and proof of satisfactory payment arrangements with the Cashier's Office has been show to the School of Dental Medicine Office of Student Affairs.
