**REFUND POLICY**: It is to the financial advantage of all students withdrawing, or dropping classes to do so as early in the semester as possible. Refunds for tuition and required fees (excluding room and board charges which are determined by contractual agreement\*) will be made as per the appropriate summer session schedule detailed below. No refunds will be considered after the designated limited refund period(s). To officially withdraw, a student must give written notice to the Office of the Registrar.

**POLICY EXCEPTION**: There will be no refunds available on special course fees including but not limited to private music fees, remedial math, or nursing fees after the first week of classes (five class days commencing with and inclusive of the first officially published day of classes for the University)\*.

## **REFUND SCHEDULE** *First Summer Session*

Beginning May 21, 2018 (or the 6th consecutive class day) refunds will not be considered. If a student wishes to appeal, the process must be initiated in writing to the Tuition Refund Appeals Committee.
